Alessi endorsed by New York League of Conservation Voters

Marc Alessi announced he has been officially endorsed by the New York League of Conservation Voters (NYLCV). Alessi has been working in the Assembly to promote alternative energies – such as biofuels – to make New York’s homes, businesses and municipalities more energy efficient.
